**Brief description of the job:**

**Key responsibilities**

- To maintain a good understanding of the Sea Animal Encounters operation by attending weekly staff meetings and get update on all changes to the sea Animal Encounters operations.
- To ensure all guests are thoroughly briefed on the rules and regulations governing our operations (ocean walker, shark cage dive, snorkel lagoon), prior and after every activity and maintain feedback from guests upon completion of every activity.
- To maintain constant vigilance on guests during an operation and undertake or initiate any corrective action.
- To ensure all activities set ups are done by 8h00am and packed away at the closing time before either 17h00 or 18h00pm depending on season.
- To report all faults in a fault register book at closing time each day. To record any feedback from guests in the guest feedback book on a daily basis.
- To attend scheduled training and retraining programs every year.
- To ensure all guests indemnity forms, log form, and medical forms are being checked and signed before and after any dive.
- To ensure that all activities wristbands are being collected, stamped, off and attached to the appropriate signed document before any dive.
- To ensure compliance with all the diving regulations on a daily basis.
- Between 9h00 to 11h00am to promote the sea Animal encounters products to approaching guests by distributing pamphlets to at least 20 guests daily.
- To manage all Diving assets: Mask, snorkel, life vest, cylinders, Bcd, shark cage, umbilical cord, wetsuits, diving boots, Db box, by ensuring that daily cleaning and maintenance are carried out.
- To interact with GRO, Saambr staff, Happy snappy, maintenance, safety, cleaning and ticketing on a daily basis.
